

# Faces of Hope

## Host Information

The Faces of Hope exhibit currently consists of 24 – 20x24 photo canvases, 3 – 30x40 collogue photo canvases, 2 sponsorship boards, and up to 6 autism statistic boards. The exhibit is loaned in smaller portions as well as in its entirety. We ask that the exhibit remain at the host's location for 4-6 weeks to minimize the handling and wear and tear on the canvas pieces. Our exhibit is best suited for wall hanging but can be displayed using solid black wooden easels provided by The ISAAC Foundation. In the event of using a wooden easel display, we ask that the exhibit be partitioned off to minimize the possibility of damage to the pieces. The exhibit is hung by an ISAAC Foundation volunteer and the host is encouraged to be present at the time of set-up to verify exhibit location and display restrictions, if any. The exhibit requires no maintenance other than an occasional dry dusting, if deemed necessary.

Host participants confirmed by March 15<sup>th</sup> will be included in a Faces of Hope location announcement postcard sent to the Foundation mailing list.

### ***I HEREBY AGREE:***

Each object at all times shall be given due care to protect it against loss, damage or deterioration. All objects shall be protected at all times from rain, excessive humidity or dry conditions, or extreme or rapid changes in temperature. All objects shall be protected against fading, scorching, reticulation and cackling caused by direct or reflect sunlight, strong artificial light, ultraviolet radiation from fluorescent tubes or proximity to heat sources.

The exhibit shall be shown in a dignified and suitable manner at the site set forth above.

The public shall be admitted to the exhibit without any restrictions involving race or ethnic heritage and with reasonable provision for its accessibility to the handicapped.

The exhibit must include prominent display of the Sponsorship Boards at all times.

All publicity releases, invitations, announcements, catalogues, and other printed matter concerning or related to the exhibit must state that: "The exhibit is presented by The ISAAC Foundation."

Photographs and related text and artwork in this exhibit are copyright and carry all restrictions normally associated with copyrighted materials

It may become necessary for The ISAAC Foundation to withdraw works or objects from the exhibit while it is in circulation. Such a withdrawal will only be made for good and unforeseen cause as determined by The ISAAC Foundation Executive Director.

The Faces of Hope exhibit shall remain in the possession of the borrower for the time specified in this agreement. In the event a new owner takes possession of the location establishment, the new owner will be required to return the Faces of Hope exhibit pursuant to the terms of this agreement.

There will be no compensation from The ISAAC Foundation to the host "borrower" for hosting the Faces of Hope exhibit.

There will be a suitable representative from host's establishment at the time the exhibit is installed to supervise the installation of the Faces of Hope exhibit and will clearly specify limitations and/or restrictions with regard to the installation of said exhibit.
